Son of Thomas Cullen (a Merchant) and Mary Kate McDermott. Married Annie Casey on 20th April 1927 in Drumlish Church, County Longford. Awarded the Silver Scott Medal in 1930 while stationed in Cappawhite, County Tipperary after he rescued a woman who was kidnapped by three armed men at brought to Sologhead Church. Retired on 16th June 1953 and worked as a Shopkeeper. Resided at Abbey Road, Monkstown, Dublin. Died on 19th April 1971 in St. Columcilles Hospital. He is buried in Deansgrange Cemetery, Dublin.
