FURTHER NOTES

Son of Patrick McGonagle (a farmer) and Bridget Lafferty. Served as a Sergeant during the Irish Civil War. Resigned from the Gardai on the 20th September 1926, the same day as his brother Garda Thomas McGonagle (Reg No. 2104) also resigned. Hugh emigrated with Tom to America and died there on 2nd April 1974
