FURTHER NOTES

Son of Michael Nagle (a labourer) and Mary Larkin. Held the rank of Sergeant. Died while serving at the Garda Barracks in Cuffs Grange in Kilkenny on 23rd October 1925 at the age of 22. His cause of death was poisoning, although it is inconclusive at Corner's Inquest if it was accidental, self-administered or a homicide. He is buried in Lisboney Cemetery at the old Dublin Road in Nenagh.
