Married Anna Nolan on 1st August 1928 in Ashford Church, County Wicklow. Retired on 24th April 1964 and resided in George's Avenue, Blackrock, Dublin. Died on 7th June 1966 at his home. He was buried with full military honours in Deansgrange Cemetery, Dublin.
