Upon retirement in 1958 set up an auctioneer business in Kilkee, County Clare, where he was also a town commissioner for Fianna Fail. Died on 24th September 1981 in St. Joseph's Hospital in Ballina, County Mayo. He is buried in Lisdeen Cemetery, Kilkee.
