Married Noreen Browne on 10th July 1935 in St. Michael and John's Church, Dublin. Resided in Inistioge, County Kilkenny. Died on 9th October 1973 in Waterford County Hospital. He is buried in Saint Marys Churchyard, Inistioge. His son Eddier Keher is an All-Ireland GAA player for Kilkenny Hurling Team.
