**FURTHER NOTES**

Son of John Corry and Ellen Coffey and was one of eight children. He was an Adjutant in the 6th Battalion East Clare Brigade IRA during the War of Independence. During the Irish Civil War he was assigned to the 1st Western Division and later transferred to the Military Police, where he worked from April 1923 to February 1924. He was posted to Kiltimagh, County Mayo. He married Catherine Nolan on 22nd September 1925 at Kiltartan Church near Gort, County Galway. They had three sons and one daughter all born in Aidan Street, Kiltimagh. During his entire policing career of 30 years, he remained in Kiltimagh until he retired on 7th December 1953. He died on 29th January 1978 in Kiltimagh and is buried in the local cemetery with his wife and daughter at Kilkinure.
